**Departmental Update-Sheriff:** Sheriff Mike Moyer provided the Board with an update to his department and how Covid19 is affecting the department.

<u>Commissioners Annual Report:</u> County Administrator Shackett presented the Commissioners annual report. Commissioner Taylor requested the word preoccupied be changed to focused. M/Waring to approve the report with the change requested, S/Taylor. County Administrator Shackett called roll: Waring-yes DeVoy-yes and Taylor-yes. Unanimous. **Motion passed**.

<u>Accept Donation-Nursing Home:</u> Nursing Home Administrator Shelley Richardson requested the Board accept the donation of 2 iPads. M/Waring to accept donations, S/Taylor. County

County Attorney Andrew Livernois had a long meeting with the AG's office and other County Attorney's. The AG's office thought Belknap County is a model for the way inmate releases have been handled. Commissioner Taylor stated he is very impressed with the cooperation between Superintendent and County Attorney.
