Departmental Update-Restorative Justice: Restorative Justice Director Mike MacFadzen provided the Board with an update on his department. He spoke of the changes in programs due to Covid-19.

<u>Financial Update:</u> Accounting Manger Lori Sharp reviewed the financial reports any large variances were noted. She noted the Nursing Home receivables are being collected but revenues are down due to reduced census.

<u>Ratify vote to implement stipend for mandated overtime:</u> County Administrator Shackett called roll to ratify the vote to implement the stipend for mandated overtime in the nursing home: DeVoy-yes, Waring-yes and Taylor-yes. Unanimous. **Motion passed**.

<u>Consider CDBG</u>: County Administrator Shackett stated a grant administrator had been in contact with her regarding the Board applying for grant money to help local agencies affected by Covid-19. The Board would like Donna Lane to attend a future meeting to discuss the grant.

Other: County Administrator Shackett stated additional Cares act money was received with no information and that they are looking into it. She stated she had been notified that HealthTrust is going to have a significant surplus this year due to Covid and final amount will come out in November.

<u>Public Comment:</u> Mike Sylvia, Belmont-stated he was curious about the ratifying the NH stipend mandate. He inquired about the stipend and the way the Board voted on it outside of a public meeting. Commissioner DeVoy provided an explanation on the stipend.
